

CONDITIONS

- a) The income and property of the Society shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects of the society as set forth in the memorandum of association and no portion here off shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, to the members of the society.
- b) No member of the governing body of the society, shall be appointed to any salaried office of the society, no remuneration shall be given by society to any member of the governing body except repayment of out of pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises / demises to the society.
- c) The society by its constitution is required to apply its profits, if any, or other income in promoting its objects.
- d) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the society then remain after satisfaction of all debts and liabilities any property whatever, the same shall not be paid to be or distributed among the members of the society, but shall be given on transferred to some other institutions having objects similar to the objects of the society to be determined by society at or before the time of dissolution.
- e) The society can not sell its property / properties whatsoever in any manner and under any circumstances.

The management of the affairs of the society is entrusted in accordance with the rules and Regulations of the society to a governing Body of which the present members are :

4. Aims and Objects :

- (a) To provide Shelter / accommodation to poor, needy, old men, widow, physically handicapped & disabled persons.
- (b) To help / provide education to poor.
- (c) To help / provide financial help in marriages of poor girls.
- (d) To provide help in every way to up lift the poor.
- (e) To open B.ED College, Nursing College, J.B.T., E.T.T., Degree College or to run any professional course for public.
- (f) To open, run dispensary & Hospitals.
- (g) To start, establish, run, takeover, manage and maintain of Nursery, Primary, Middle, High & Higher Secondary Schools and Degree Colleges, Computer centres, Polytechnical and Professional Colleges, Different trades of industrial training centres, Gurukul & Hostels for Boys & Girls in rural and urban areas.
- (h) Teaching of Modern arts and science on up to date lines in less expenditure.
- (i) Teaching of ideology of great Indian Saints, Leader & educationists.
- (j) To obtain money for the aims & objects of the Society in the law full manner and to apply to deal with the same in such a manner as may be considered the most desirable for giving effect to such aims & objects.
- (k) To do all such things as are identical and conducive for attainment of the above aims & objects or any of them.

POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF GENERAL BODY

- To hold the election of the members of the governing body every second year.
- b) The governing body shall be consists of minimum 5 members including the following office bearers :-
1. Chairman
 2. President
 3. Vice President & Treasurer
 4. General Secretary
 5. Jt. Secretary
- c) The members of the governing body shall hold office for a term of two years from the date of election of the society till the new governing body is elected in next general meeting.
- d) Only founder members and whole life members / trustees shall be eligible for the election of the members of the governing body.

5. POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF GOVERNING BODY

- i) To hold the election of the office bearers of the governing body .
- ii) Management of The Society .
- iii) The Governing body can form various committees or sub committees for smooth functioning and to achieve aims and objects of the society . The number of the committee or sub - committees will be decided by the governing body as it thinks fit , and these committee or sub committees will work under the guidance / supervision of the Chairman of the committee or sub committee appointed by the Governing body.

6. POWER AND DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS

A) CHAIRMAN

- i) To preside over the meetings and gatherings of the governing body as well as of the society . To take votes to declare the result of voting . To determine the order of priority when several proposals are to be laid before the committee .

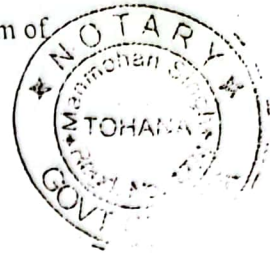

- ii) To confirm and approve the proceedings of the meeting .
- iii) To remove from a meeting , a member for disorderly conduct .
- iv) To appoint any member as election Chairman for election of the members of governing body of the society .

B) PRESIDENT

President will exercise all the powers of the Chairman in his absence. He will look after the works entrusted to him by the Chairman. He will assist the Chairman in performing his duties.

C) GENERAL SECRETARY AND JOINT SECRETARY

The Secretary shall be the chief executive office of the Society and his powers and duties generally shall be :-

- a) To conduct the correspondence of the Society, maintain all records , to give effect to the decisions of the governing body and issue notices for meeting , draw annual reports prepare minutes of the general body and governing body meeting etc.
- b) To execute contracts etc. Sanctioned by the governing body on behalf of society along with the president and other office bearers.
- c) To carry on any other duty which the governing may entrust to him in the interest of the society.

In the absence of General Secretary , the Jt . Secretary will have all those rights and duties , which the Secretary has.

D) VICE PRESIDENT & TREASURER

The Vice President & Treasurer shall collect funds and issue receipts , make authorised payments on behalf of the Society . He shall also co-operate with the General Secretary and President generally in the discharge of the above stated functions.

7. MEETING

GENERAL MEETING

- i) The General body shall hold the annual meeting in the month of July.
- ii) The governing body shall hold the half yearly meeting in the month of July and December.
